Scope Rules

In the sample source code, there is function prototype

cout << "Local num is: " << num << " in local_example - end" << endl;

// num1 in main is not within scope - so it can't be used here.

The function prototype should be:

```
void local example(int);
```

The way that it is currently written it will work fine, but we are overloading the <code>local_example</code> function, which is not the what we wanted to do.
